Projects have included industrial centres, residential developments, urban mixed use centres, waterfronts and new cities. Generally my role has been working as part of a team with design, 3D modelling, rendering (Cinema4D), analysis, guidelines, indexes, production and documentation.

With recent projects I have been participating in the design for both Dubai and Umm Al Quwain framework plans in the United Arab Emirates and have designed mixed use developments in Saudi Arabia, working closely with overseas clients, local architects and consultants in this process.

Developing town planning submissions and working drawings including extensive work on a proposed service centre in Melbourne Docklands for McDonalds.
